• Bevsehir Lake - Yesildağ (Storks Valley) Development of Ecotourism Infrastructure Project 2017

Within the scope of the project with the financial support of the United Nations, GEF/SGP-Turkey; healthy food production and nature guidance trainings were given to housewives and secondary school students, respectively in order to support ecotourism. Population and breeding successes of the storks in the colony were observed. Stork nests can be monitored on the website of the Municipality of Beysehir with a camera system established to view the stork nests. Eight artificial nests were placed in the breeding area of the storks. The power lines causing stork mortality were isolated by MEDAS and a bird observation tower in the Storks Valley were constructed by the National Parks.

• Environmental Protection and Ecotourism (Storks Hill) Project in Beyşehir (Adaköy-Yeşildağ) 2019

Within the scope of the project with the financial support of the United Nations, GEF/SGP-Turkey; secondary school students were provided with nature guidance training and housewives with diversification of dairy products, good agriculture and organic agriculture practices and certification in order to support ecotourism. Storks and breeding were monitored on Adaköy Storks Hill. Live images of stork nests are provided through a camera system established for viewing on the website of Beysehir Municipality. An observation tower was built by Beyşehir Municipality. The totems pointing to the stork observation towers on highways and stork information boards were placed near the observation towers.





In the project realized with a grant from the World Bank; The Ministry of Tourism, Ankara University and experts of our Association provided training for farmers and women of the region on home boarding, organic agriculture, product processing and marketing.

Environmental Awareness Raising in Primary Education Project 2009

In cooperation with Ankara Provincial Directorate of National Education and our Association, environmental education materials were prepared for environmental protection, savings and solid wastes. Through the Gölbaşı District Governorship, environmental protection trainings were given to the 4th and 5th grade students of two primary schools, one urban and the other rural in Gölbaşı District.

Rural Tourism Development Project in Çağa Town of Ankara Province 2012

Within the scope of the project supported by Ankara Development Agency, a management plan was developed for the development of rural tourism in the region. In addition, a recreation area on the bank of İlhan Creek and a market place were projected. Women of the region have been trained by experts on hygiene in food production and healthy nutrition. The old laundry house of the town has been restored and converted into a cultural center as designed as a place for women's social activities.

Vocational Qualification Transfer Systems in Ecology (ECO-MATRIX) 2011-2013

The objective of the project, which is supported by the National Agency under the Lifelong Learning Program is to promote a desire more about the natural environment further and to equip the target groups with the knowledge and skills need to apply the basic principles and practices of resource management and ecology to complex environmental issues.

• Environmental Youth Project 2015

With the financial support of the Ministry of Youth and Sports, trainings were given to 9th and 10th grade students of 11 high schools in Çubuk District in Ankara to develop their attitudes, value judgments and sense of responsibility. In addition, natural areas, solid waste dumping ground, drinking water treatment plant of the District were examined on site. A photography contest on environment was organized among students.
